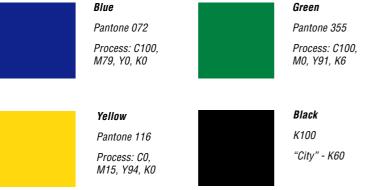

This Corporate Identity Guidelines deals with the basic elements and rules for reproduction and application of the Tauranga District Council visual identity.

Consistent reproduction and application of the identities will ensure that the integrity and high standards of the Tauranga District Council's brand communications are maintained.

Authorisation

All use of the Tauranga District Council brand must follow the following guidelines and must be AUTHORISED from the Tauranga District Council Communications Unit.

To ensure high quality reproduction standards, it is essential that the identities are always originated from the bromides or the electronic artwork which can be obtained from the Tauranga District Council Communications Division. A full Brand Management Kit is also available with complete guidelines and samples.

Elements

The visual identity for the Tauranga District Council has two elements: the Tauranga City logo (2 formats) and the supporting Tauranga District Council landform graphic element (2 formats).

Both identities are to be used in support of each other on all applications produced by / or promoting the Tauranga District Council. The relationship of the two elements is the landform graphic element must appear on the bottom of the application.

The Tauranga City identity is to be placed on its own where its application is to illustrate a supporting role of the Tauranga District Council.

The Tauranga City logo has a portrait and landscape format to suit its application. The portrait format being the preferred use.

In colour applications it is important that the identities are clear and distinctive. There should be as much contrast as possible between the identities and their backgrounds to allow for maximum legibility.

General colour application is the Tauranga City logo to appear on a white or blue background with the supporting Tauranga District Council landform graphic element in green.

Applications of the identities other than those illustrated must be avoided

Single Colour

When reproducing the Tauranga District Council identities in single colour, pantone® blue 072 should be used.

If printing on coloured paper ie yellow paper black or blue options should be used.

Preferred single colour application is:

1. Blue on white background

Two Colour

When reproducing the identities in Two colour, green and blue should be used. Note: The landform element should be reproduced in green.

Preferred two colour applications is: 1. Green logo on blue background.

Optional two colour applications are:

- 1. Blue logo on green background.
- 2. Blue logo on yellow background for impact/promotional material such as covers.

Three Colour

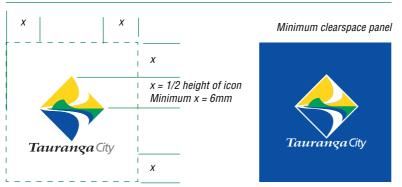
When reproducing the Tauranga City identities in Three colour, the outlined icon should be used with the logotype in either blue or white to suit the dark or light background.





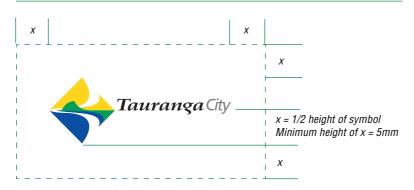


Specifications Minimum Space & Size

Tauranga City landscape format Identity minimum clearspace and size



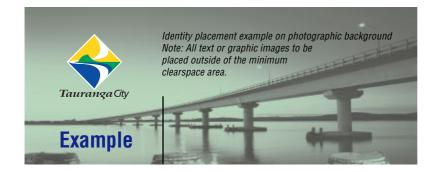
Tauranga District Council landform graphic element minimum clearspace and size

Proportional scale of landform graphic element (A) to suit the application independent to the type - type must not exceed 1/2 the width of landform



Proportional scale of landform graphic element (B) to suit the application independent to the type - type must not exceed 1/4 the width of landform

Tauranga District CouncilXx = 6mm = 6 point minimum point size of type1/4 width of landform



Minimum clearspace

Minimum clearspace has been established to ensure that the identities are not crowded by typography or graphic elements. This is illustrated by the dotted rules. To ensure that the identities stands out on the page, no other graphic element or typography should be positioned within this area.

The minimum clearspace of the Tauranga City identity is proportional to the height of the icon - the measurement x is 1/2 the height of the icon. The graphic system illustrates how the minimum clearspace is obtained by using values of x.

Note: Wherever possible clearspace should be increased.

Minimum Size

To ensure quality reproduction and legibility of the identities, a minimum size has been established. This is equivalent to a minimum point size of 6 point for type and the wordmark.
